

Abstract. Among the many important contributions of Thomas Aquinas regarding the virtue of justice, his interpretation of Aristotle's position stands out, especially when he discusses book V of the *Nicomachean Ethics*. Aquinas makes a peculiar exegesis: not only a paraphrase, but an original doctrine elaborated as a consequence of his own study about justice. I present here a summary of this topic, which I have developed in detail in a larger work that was written as a dissertation to obtain the degree of Bachelor in Philosophy, which the committee qualified with the highest grade.
