

Abstract. This translation of a text by the Seraphic Doctor is part of a project aimed at studying the notion of natural and deliberative will in thirteenth century authors. This is an issue of particular theoretical and historical relevance. The question here presented deals with how to understand the natural and the deliberative will, according to Peter Lombard's text. Note that the problem of the division of the will occupied the minds of Christian thinkers, who dealt equally with the interpretation of the evangelical passages on the will of Christ, and with the commented authorities. In this case, Bonaventure deals with Peter Lombard, a task which involved the incorporation of the interpretative work of previous authors, such as John of Damascus and Hugh of Saint Victor, and also the dialogue with his contemporaries.
